The Idyllwild Fire Crew 621 program is designed to develop Firefighter candidates through training and hands-on application of wildland fire procedures. Through a process of continuing education, observing, and learning directly from Fire Service professionals, Crew members will be given the opportunity to work in the Wildland fire environment, to develop and enhance appropriate skills, experience and knowledge.

Under direct supervision of Fire Service professionals, Crew members will perform a vast variety of emergency operations that will teach them how to protect lives and property including fire suppression, emergency medical services, and maintenance of stations, grounds, equipment, fire prevention inspections, as well as other important fire-related tasks as assigned.

Minimum Requirements:

Minimum age of 18 years old at time of application.

Prior to starting the program, Candidates must possess a valid California Class C Driver's License.

IFPD recommends that potential Candidates work towards obtaining the following training prior to beginning the program: a State recognized FF1 training academy, completion of a wildland training program, College units in Fire Science, Intro, Fire 101. All applicants will submit a DOJ background/life scan, and be successful through the appointment process: Selection Interview, physical abilities and general aptitude testing prior to appointment.

Are you looking for an opportunity to gain experience, build knowledge and prepare yourself for a career in the fire service?

As an Idyllwild Crew 621 member you'll:

Respond to alarms, rescue, and other emergency calls for service. Assist in protecting life and property endangered by fire or other hazards. Administer first aid, Participate in fire prevention activities including inspecting commercial and residential structures to ensure compliance with fire prevention laws and regulations. Participate in regular training, drills, and study activities. Assist in the maintenance of the fire station, fire trucks, rescue units, and other apparatus and equipment.

You may be asked to participate in scheduled public relations activities. Perform other related duties as assigned.

How often am I required to Participate?

Idyllwild Fire Department Shift Schedules are 48/96, Reserve opportunities can be scheduled for 12, 24 and 48 hour intervals. (A minimum commitment of 48 hours monthly is required.)
