The IFPD Fire Reserve Intern program is designed to develop future Firefighter candidates through training and hands-on application in order to help them reach their ultimate career goals of becoming Firefighters. Through a process of continuing education, observing, and learning directly from Fire Service professionals, Interns will be given the opportunity to develop the appropriate skills to move them closer to a Fire Service career.

Under direct supervision of Fire Service professionals, Interns will jointly perform a variety of emergency operations that will teach them how to protect lives and property including fire suppression, emergency medical services, and maintenance of stations, maintenance of grounds, maintenance of equipment, and fire prevention inspections, as well as other important fire-related tasks as assigned.

Minimum Requirements:

Minimum age of 18 years old at time of application.

Prior to starting the program, Interns must possess a valid California Class C Driver's License and current EMT certification.

IFPD recommends that Intern Candidates work towards obtaining the following training prior to beginning the program: a State recognized FF1 training academy, completion of a wildland training program, College units in Fire Science, Intro, Fire 101. All applicants will submit a DOJ background/life scan, and be successful through the appointment process: Selection Interview, physical abilities and general aptitude testing prior to appointment.

Are you looking for an opportunity to gain experience, build knowledge and prepare yourself for a career in the fire service?

As a Reserve Firefighter you will:

Respond to alarms, rescue, and other emergency calls for service. Assist in protecting life and property endangered by fire or other hazards. Administer first aid, Participate in fire prevention activities including inspecting commercial and residential structures to ensure compliance with fire prevention laws and regulations. Participate in regular training, drills, and study activities. Assist in the maintenance of the fire station, fire trucks, rescue units, and other apparatus and equipment.

You may be asked to participate in scheduled public relations activities. Perform other related duties as assigned.

How often am I required to Participate?

Idyllwild Fire Department Shift Schedules are 48/96, Reserve opportunities can be scheduled for 12, 24 and 48 hour intervals. (A minimum commitment of 48 hours monthly is required.)

All Reserve Firefighter Interns receive a stipend of \$ 75.00 per 24 hr. shift to cover such incidentals as travel, meals etc. This stipend is NOT to be considered hourly pay and is not to be associated in any way with employment. *There are instances where an Intern Reserve Firefighter would be eligible to work at an hourly pay rate as assigned.*
